You'll be presenting to school librarians from around the state at the 2017 Alabama School Library Association annual summer conference on June 12, 2017, at Vestavia Hills High School. Here's how it will work: the moderator of the session (a librarian), will ask for students to talk about books from page 1, page 2, page 3, and so on. If you've read a book on that page, you can stand and talk about why you liked or didn't like it. Several students may talk about the same book. Your information will help librarians learn about these books and decide whether to buy or recommend them.

Please REGISTER USING THE GOOGLE FORM below read at least 3 books from YALSA's 2017 Best Fiction for Young Adults list (link below). We would, however, love for you to report on as many as you would like to read. Keep in mind that the starred books were chosen as the Top 10, so please make a point to read at least 2 books that did not earn the Top 10 designation. This will give the attending librarians information about a broader set of books.

Please arrive at Vestavia Hills High no later than 9:30. We'll talk for a minute about how the session will run. The session lasts from 10:00 until 10:45, and lunch will be provided afterward. We are looking forward to hearing your feedback!
